

Getting Started with Explorer



Install Explorer onto your mobile device

You will need to install Explorer to your mobile device

- **iPhone/iPad:** go to the App Store on your device



- **Samsung/Android:** go to the Play Store on your device



Search for and install the following app:

- Explorer for ArcGIS



Log in to Explorer

1. Open the Explorer for ArcGIS app.
2. To log in, tap the **ArcGIS Enterprise** option and type in the following URL:

3. Tap **Continue**

4. Enter your usual ECan email as the username and your password

5. Tap **Sign In**



The property search tool is used to find information related to a specific property. It can be useful to understand what consents a property has or to find contacts via CRM (plus many more) before heading out for a site visit.


Download the Map – For Offline Use

When no cell coverage is available, the map will need to be downloaded prior to going out, by selecting the arrow next to the map




Using the Map

Once logged in to explorer using your EcanMaps login you will see all the maps and groups that have been shared with you. The property search map is available to all EcanMaps users.



- 1 Search – This is where you can search for maps that are available to you.
- 2 Sort – this is where you can change the order that the maps are displayed to you. You can sort by relevance, title and date.
- 3 Account – View the account you have used to sign in and the settings associated with it.
- 4 Current – This shows the map you currently have open. Select it to return to where you left off.
- 5 Recent – This shows maps you may have opened recently or use frequently
- 6 Three dots - Options to view map details, add the map to you favourites. You can also check for map updates (if you have offline maps)



- 1 Go back to all maps
- 2 Search for features in the map
- 3 Bookmarked locations
- 4 Layer list – tick layers on and off
- 5 More tools – measure tool
- 6 Find my location
- 7 Drawing – captures sketches and notes on the map
- 8 Features are highlighted when clicked in the map
- 9 The highlighted feature shows in the pop up at the bottom of the screen (scroll through this to get all the information)
- 10 Get directions to the highlighted feature from your current location
- 11 Bookmark this feature
